FOREWORD

THE last time that Mr. Benson showed his oil paintings in New York was in 1920 when, in company with the late Willard Metcalf, he filled the walls of our old gallery with a collection that many of our visitors will still remember. Six years before that, we had shown for the first time his gauche drawings of game birds,—the forerunners of the distinguished etchings now so well known throughout the country.

The public who know his work only through those exhibitions, will find in this new group a surprising variety. Interiors with figures, long associated with his name; sporting subjects made so familiar by his skillful needle; out-of-door figure studies flooded with sunlight; rich, colorful still-life compositions that have represented him in recent public exhibitions; all are included. And in them all is that masterful quality that makes the name of Benson one of the really bright spots in American Art.
