

Horace Day was born of American parents in Amoy, China, in 1909. He attended preparatory school in Shanghai after which he entered the Art Students' League in New York City. He is a member of the Tiffany Foundation at Oyster Bay, Long Island. Mr. Day was until recently instructor in art at the Henry Street Settlement, leaving there to become director of the Art School in Augusta, Georgia, where he now is. He is one of the best known of the younger contemporaries, and his work has been seen in many of the large exhibitions including the International Water Color Exhibition at the Art Institute of Chicago, and the Whitney Museum. This is his second one-man show in our galleries. Paintings and water colors by Mr. Day are in a number of private collections, and recently his "Equinox" was purchased for the permanent collection of the Canajoharie Art Gallery, Canajoharie, New York.
