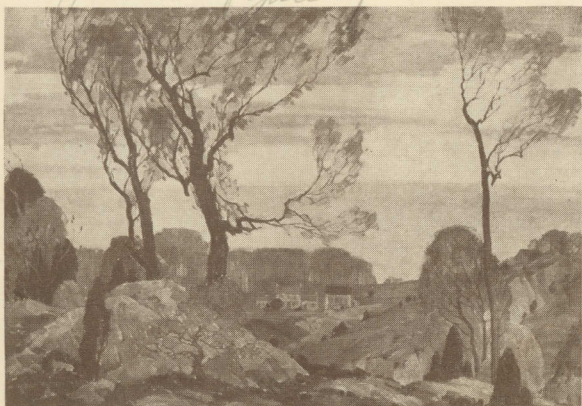

ARTHUR MELTZER was born in Minneapolis thirty-six years ago. After local study, he won a fellowship at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts and later was awarded the Cresson Traveling Scholarship of the same school.

His summers are spent at Mystic, Conn., where he is under the helpful influence of Mr. Charles H. Davis. He is an important contributor to the summer exhibitions there, and he has been included in most of the large annual shows throughout the East.
