January 1923 at the Macbeth Gallery, Orland Campbell gave his first "One-Man Show". February 1925 there was a second show at Palm Beach. The current showing is his third. Since 1923 this painter's time has been devoted almost entirely to portrait painting; five of the past seven years in California.

The present exhibition is retrospective in the sense that certain canvasses which will indicate the nature of the painter's development over an eighteen year interval are herewith presented. Of the California period, although portraits of Mary Pickford, Ronald Colman in costume of Sydney Carton, and Mary Hay Barthelmess were among those commissioned, only the smaller painting of Miss Gwynne Pickford is being shown.

Born in Chicago of American-born parents Campbell lived his early life in Washington D. C. Unable to study art as planned, in Paris, because of the first World War, his single academic year of 1915 was spent at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts with Henry McCarter.

Campbell is not a realist. His wish is to tell his story simply, vitally, decoratively.
