MR. LAVALLE is one of the Boston group of painters. He studied at the Boston Museum School of Fine Arts under Leslie P. Thompson and Philip L. Hale, and later at the Academie Julien in Paris. His work has been exhibited in every large exhibition in this country as well as the Paris Salon.
