PLACE -- Between Kennebunkport and Biddeford Pool, 90 miles from Boston.

COURSES - Two terms of 4 weeks each: July 2 through 28; August 1 through 29.

TUITION FEES - One term -- \$40. Eight weeks -- \$70.

Private lesson (2 hours) -- \$10. Semi-private lesson (4 students or less) - \$5.

Single class lesson - \$3. Term fees payable in advance.

INSTRUCTION -- Both courses are an application of the teaching in Mr. O'Hara's book, "MAKING WATERCOLOR BEHAVE", Minton, Balch & Co., publishers.

OUTLINE OF COURSE: Abstract brush drill. Application of brush-strokes to landscape. Value pictures, black and white. Warm and cold color. The spectrum, light and pigments. Receding surfaces, third dimension. Character of trees, rocks, water, surfaces. Effects of sunlight, wind, temperature, etc. Design in painting. Painting by theory.

THE CLASS meets daily, except Sunday, with Mr. O'Hara and his instructor. Mr. O'Hara gives each student individual criticism besides that in the general class criticism which is held once a week. He also paints "demonstration" watercolors several times a week. During each term there is outdoor painting from a model. An exhibition of students' work is held toward the end of each month. Materials are sold at the School at regular retail prices.

SUBJECTS FOR PAINTING: Goose Rocks Beach offers a great variety in subjects. It is also a center from which trips are made with the class: to Portland Harbor, Danish Village, historic houses of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport, fishing coves of Cape Porpoise, the river at York and the cliffs and sand-dunes of Ogunquit.

A GENERAL EXHIBITION of watercolors by nationally known painters will be held in The Watercolor Gallery from July 1st to August 15th. From August 15th to September 15th Mr. O'Hara's own watercolors will be shown.

LIVING COSTS - Nearby rooms, \$5 to \$10 a week. Board, \$10 a week up. Hotels, \$18 a week up. Furnished cottages.

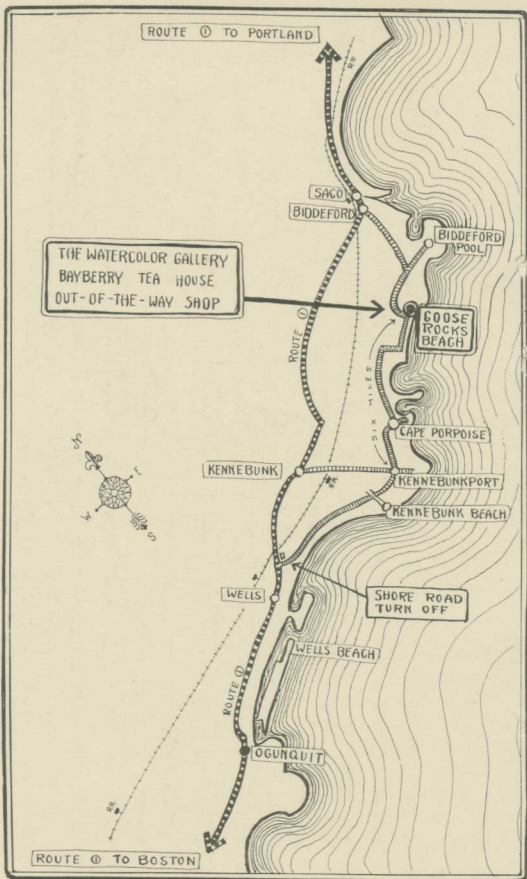
