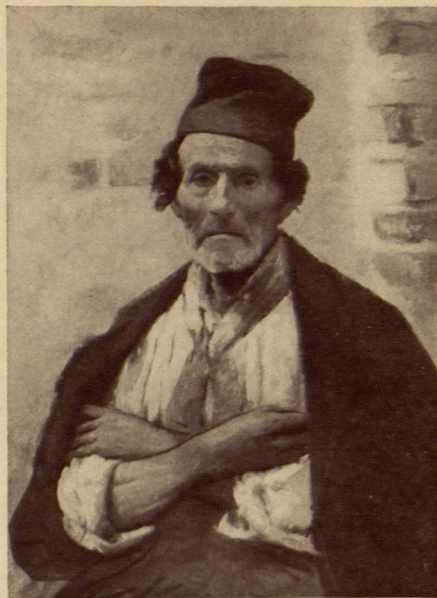

THE GALLERY VISITOR who has not seen the collection of Duveneck's paintings assembled in the Cincinnati Museum can have no adequate conception of his work. From his early days in Munich with Currier, Eakins, Chase, Twachtman and others, to his later portraits painted while director of the Art School of the Cincinnati Museum, there is so much variety of treatment, and such a logical development of that variety, that to see only a few examples is to get but a vague idea of what Duveneck really stood for.

His pupils look back to him as an able and interested instructor; Cincinnati honors him as a vital force for the best of art in that community; those less intimately associated with him know him largely as the painter of the "Whistling Boy," of which, with some variations, he painted several replicas. It is partly on this account that his Munich period, which this represents, is taken as most typical of Duveneck, the painter. It is partly, too, because in that period he was the painter, pure and simple, engaged strenuously in the work of the creative artist. The canvases which came to completion in later years were produced largely as the avocation of a man on whom other interests had forced their attention.

The group which we are privileged to show, and a few of which are offered for sale, belong to the Duveneck family. They represent a wide divergence of dates, subjects, and methods and will serve as a brief introduction to a man, too little known in the East, whose best work must take a high place among American painters.
