FOREWORD

ABOUT fifteen years ago when Mr. Ryder came back from abroad, it was our good fortune to secure the first pictures which he offered to the American public. During succeeding seasons we have never had occasion to regret adding his name to our list of exhibitors. Year by year his output has increased in those peculiar qualities which he has made his own, and year by year his circle of admirers and of collectors has widened.

Last season his Academy picture was purchased without solicitation by the Metropolitan Museum, and his "Mount Lovewell" in the Chicago Art Institute was bought by the Friends of American Art,—his second in their collection. These are but two of the several recent honors that have come to him.

During the time we have had Mr. Ryder's work it has been possible to make only two special exhibitions for him, the latest, two years ago. We are particularly pleased therefore to have this opportunity to present a group of new canvases which represent the best of what he has completed since that time.
