## Foreword

THERE is a too prevalent idea that only the very wealthy can afford to buy American paintings. This is due largely to the figures quoted at big exhibitions where, for the most part, the artists send their largest canvases, most of which are too big, both in size and price, for the consideration of home owners of comparatively moderate incomes.

The present group has been assembled to give a general idea not only of what pictures are actually available, but to show what artists, among others, are willing so to price their works that lovers of pictures, not perhaps as collectors, but as home owners seeking one or two pictures to make those homes more attractive, can afford to buy them.








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
