FOREWORD

LONG the eastern seaboard are a number of long-established colonies of painters whose work, as individuals, is shown frequently during the winter in galleries in New York and elsewhere. These colonies have exhibitions during the summer through which it is possible to see together the work of the painters taken as a group, and they are interesting not only for the sake of the pictures themselves but for the flavor of the place that dominates most of the work. Comparatively few of our gallery visitors have a chance to visit these summer exhibitions,—to see at first hand what interests our artists in their summer homes. We have accordingly arranged to show selections from three of the most important of these colonies, opening with the group catalogued here from Lyme. This will be followed in November by selections from the summer exhibition of the North Shore Art Association, whose headquarters are in Gloucester, and in December by the Society of Mystic Artists.
