*T*HIS EXHIBITION with which we open our forty-fifth season serves to illustrate one of the two chief aims we had in opening this new and smaller gallery eighteen months ago, namely, to present and keep before our public the best obtainable pictures by a limited group of the living American artists who in our opinion deserve an audience. Their works should find a place in homes where quality and good taste are the actuating motives in picture purchases. We will continue to show the work of these and a few other painters in group and occasional one-man exhibitions throughout the year.

The other part of our program is designed especially for collectors and public galleries, with whom we are working more and more in close cooperation, in finding for them desirable "collectors' items." This aim is not unique with us, but there are certain features of it that should make it of special importance to those who realize that long experience with American art is valuable and necessary in determining what is and what is not worthy of recommendation.

We shall be glad to explain the details of this Collectors' Service to those interested in obtaining authentic examples of the best American artists of both past and present. It should be of special interest to the smaller museums who want to make the best possible use of comparatively limited purchase funds. Directors of such galleries, as well as private collectors, will find it to their advantage to investigate this Service.
