## HERMANN DUDLEY MURPHY

Mr. Murphy was born at Marlboro, Massachusetts, in 1867. His studies were begun at the school of the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, and were later continued under Jean Paul Laurens, at the Academie Julian, Paris. He has frequently been awarded honors for his work, among them, medals at the Pan-American Exposition at Buffalo, and at the St. Louis World's Fair. He is a member of the New York Water Color Club and of the Copley Society of Boston, where he makes his home.

Although Mr. Murphy was represented in the exhibition of Boston Painters held here last year, and by occasional single examples, this is the first time that his work has been presented to the New York public in a special group.
